## **Main Round university offers released next week**

MORE than 80 000 people will find out next week if they have received a Main Round offer to study at university in 2010.

Applicants can check if they have an offer at [www.uac.edu.au](http://www.uac.edu.au) from 9pm on Wednesday 20 January. Letters to all applicants will arrive in the mail from Thursday 21 January. Most offers are made in the Main Round. In 2009, 55 213 offers were made and UAC expects a similar number this year.

*The Sydney Morning Herald* and *The Daily Telegraph* will publish a complete list of offers on Thursday 21 January, with local subsets in *The Canberra Times* and *The Newcastle Herald*.

The newspapers will also publish the minimum ATAR needed for entry into each course, and details of course vacancies for the Early February Round. This information will also be available on UAC's website.

Early February Round offers will be released at 9pm on Wednesday 3 February. Last year, universities made over 6 000 offers in this round. Applicants can change their course preferences for the Early February Round from 9pm on Wednesday 20 January until midnight on Tuesday 26 January via UAC's website.

University applications for study in 2010 close on Thursday 4 February. To be included in the Early February Round, applications should be submitted by Friday 22 January. Further information is available on UAC's website and in the *UAC 2010 Guide*.
