## **Mid-year university offers released**

UAC has released the Main Round of mid-year university offers today, with 2 858 offers made to applicants wanting to start university in the second semester. In the Early Round, 480 offers were made, bringing the total number of mid-year offers this year to 3 338. This is a decrease of 607 (just over 15%) on last year's total of 3 945 offers.

UAC received 5 616 applications for 2010 mid-year admissions. This is a decrease of 428 applications (almost 8%) on last year's total of 6 044 applications. This year, offers have been made to approximately 68% of applicants; last year, approximately 65% of applicants received an offer.

UAC's attention now turns to university study in 2011. Applications for more than 1 000 undergraduate courses at 17 institutions open in early August, with on-time applications closing on 30 September 2010.

The *UAC 2011 Guide* and UAC's companion website contain all the information that potential applicants need – comprehensive descriptions of courses, instructions on how to apply and information on all UAC's participating institutions.

Free copies of the *UAC 2011 Guide* will be distributed to all NSW and ACT Year 12 students in late July. All other applicants can buy a copy at newsagents for \$19.95.
