Applications continue to rise for uni in 2010

UNDERGRADUATE applications are on the rise according to figures released today by the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC). At the end of November, 80 978 people had applied through UAC, compared with 77 757 at the same time last year.

There is still time to apply for university in 2010 – applications remain open until 4 February 2010. Potential students should apply by 11 December 2009 to be in time for the Main Round of offers. Most offers are made in the Main Round – last year institutions made nearly 80 per cent of total offers in the Main Round.

Main Round offers will be released online at 9pm on Wednesday 20 January 2010. Preferences for the Main Round can be changed until midnight on 6 January 2010.
