ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Graduate diplomas and graduate certificates

Admission requirements for the various graduate diplomas and graduate certificates are normally a Bachelor degree in the appropriate discipline or an equivalent qualification supported by the completion of studies viewed as relevant by the faculty. In some cases relevant experience may be required. In some instances the admission requirements for a graduate certificate may be met by appropriate work experience or other forms of prior learning.

Masters degrees

Coursework Masters degrees usually require a three-year Bachelor degree as an entry requirement. Check the relevant faculty for further information.

Overseas qualifications and English proficiency

If you have undertaken your studies in an overseas country you may have to provide proof of proficiency in English. If you have to provide proof of English proficiency and fail to do so, you will not be considered at all for the course/s to which you have applied.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

You may have to submit additional material as part of your application depending on which course/s you apply for. Check the separate Table of courses booklet or www.uac.edu.au/postgraduate/ to see whether special requirements apply, then carefully read Table A on pages 54-55 for details.

You must send or deliver your additional material directly to the University of Sydney. Check Table A on pages 54-55 for details.

When do you have to submit your additional material?

TYPES OF PROGRAMS AVAILABLE

The University of Sydney offers a range of coursework programs at postgraduate level – Masters, Graduate Diploma and Graduate Certificate.

Some of the coursework programs offered by the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Health Sciences are offered through UAC.

Many other postgraduate coursework programs are available through direct application to the University of Sydney.

IMPORTANT DATES

Application closing dates

Refer to the separate Table of courses booklet for main closing dates. For updated closing dates including final closing dates, visit UAC's postgraduate website at www.uac.edu.au/postgraduate/.

Enrolment/Intake dates

Enrolment dates will be advised in the enrolment pack if you are successful.

ENROLMENT

Acceptance of offer

Successful applicants will have their enrolment information pack mailed to them and will be required to attend an enrolment session as specified in the pack.

Advanced standing/academic credit

Students seeking status/exemption on the basis of studies completed at another institution must complete an Application for Status form and provide an official transcript of the studies undertaken elsewhere, together with an extract of the course descriptions from the relevant faculty Handbook or equivalent. This should be submitted to the relevant faculty/department as soon as possible after a place is offered.

Deferment

It may be possible to postpone your commencement of a postgraduate program after you have received an offer. Deferment requests will be handled directly by the University of Sydney, not UAC. Apply in writing to the relevant faculty/department as soon as possible.

FEES AND CHARGES

Tuition fees

Tuition fees are calculated on a per subject basis. Refer to the separate Table of courses booklet for estimated tuition fees. For current fees information visit www.usyd.edu.au/future_students/.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Graduate coursework scholarships

The University of Sydney funds and administers a limited range of scholarships for graduate coursework study. It also administers a limited number of scholarships for which the funds come from sources external to the University.

DIRECT APPLICATIONS

The majority of the University of Sydney postgraduate coursework courses are not offered through UAC. Postgraduate research programs and Bachelor Honours programs are also not offered through UAC.

Therefore, it is important that you distinguish between those courses for which you must apply through UAC (as listed in the separate Table of courses booklet) and those courses for which you must apply directly to the University of Sydney.
