- Some institutions encourage applicants who don't have educational qualifications to sit STAT as an alternative way of qualifying for admission to tertiary study. - \*\* 3-year validity These universities and faculties will accept STAT results obtained after 2008 for 2012 admissions.

All other institutions without an asterisk (\*) do not have a restriction on the length of time STAT results remain valid.
