Your Educational Access Schemes (EAS) eligibility status

On behalf of participating institutions, I am writing to let you know about your eligibility for consideration under EAS for 2010 admissions.

When you check your eligibility status, remember that:

- being eligible for consideration under EAS at an institution does not guarantee an offer of a place, because you still have to compete for an offer to your preferred course/s with other applicants, and
- EAS consideration differs between institutions.

Queries will be answered from 4 January 2010 onwards.
