Enrolment dates

If you receive an offer of admission, you will receive information with your offer letter about acceptance and enrolment procedures.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The admission standards (including cut-offs) for courses offered in the July semester will not be lower than they were for admission in the March semester 2012. Applicants can contact the Admissions Office for information about their eligibility and competitiveness.

RESTRICTIONS ON MID-YEAR ADMISSIONS

Special entry schemes will not be available. See the 'Special Consideration' section below for more information.

Participating faculties may not be able to offer a full range of units of study (subjects) in their courses to students commencing in the July semester.

You should investigate unit of study (subjects) and progression with the faculty offering your course before applying.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION

The University's concessional entry schemes are not available for mid-year admission. However, if you have experienced some form of disadvantage you should contact the Admissions Information Office to discuss your situation. You should do this before applications for admission through UAC close.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander applicants can contact the Koori Centre for information about their services.

Students with disabilities are encouraged to contact Student Services (for courses offered at Camperdown and Darlington Campuses) or Student Central (for Health Sciences at Cumberland campus) to discuss their special requirements and the University's facilities.

Advanced standing/academic credit

Applicants who have already completed part or all of a tertiary qualification may be eligible for academic credit. You should discuss this issue with your faculty.

Deferment of offer

Deferment of enrolment is not available to applicants who receive an offer of admission for the July semester.

Your unit of study choices will determine the cost of your enrolment.

All students must pay student contributions for a Commonwealth-supported place – read section 7 in the *UAC 2012 Guide*.
