All participating institutions consider the following qualifications as equivalent to an Australian Year 12 qualification. Note that for some qualifications listed below, **certain conditions** may apply.

Some institutions may also accept other overseas secondary qualifications. Contact the institutions to which you are applying for further information – contact details for participating institutions are listed on the back cover of this Guide.

Research undertaken by UAC is the basis for determining equivalence to an Australian Year 12. This research normally involves a combination of recommendations from Australian Education International, through the National Office of Overseas Skills Recognition (AEI-NOOSR), and other resources.

**Note:** Equivalence of qualifications alone **does not** guarantee entry into courses. There are a number of factors affecting entry into a course. Entry is based on competition as places may be limited and some courses may have additional requirements. Qualifications may also be superseded by, or looked at in combination with, other assessable qualifications that you may hold – refer to the institution entries in Part 2 of this Guide.
