## **Boost your job prospects – apply for postgraduate study today**

Boosting your job prospects or earning a promotion may be as simple as submitting one online application through the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC). UAC is now taking web applications for postgraduate study in 2008.

Nine universities have more than 900 courses on offer, and you can apply for up to six courses through UAC's Apply-By-Web at [www.uac.edu.au/postgraduate.html](http://www.uac.edu.au/postgraduate.html). In a new development for 2008 admissions, UAC will be processing applications for a number of courses at La Trobe University and the University of Sydney.

If you are still deciding what to study, UAC's website ([www.uac.edu.au/postgraduate.html](http://www.uac.edu.au/postgraduate.html)) is an excellent place to begin your research. The website contains information about available courses, links to participating institutions and instructions on how to apply. It is also the starting point for your application as all applicants must apply online.

UAC Managing Director Andrew Stanton said UAC's application process makes it easier for potential students.

“You can save yourself a lot of time by applying through UAC for postgraduate coursework courses. We offer a centralised application point – UAC's website. You can look for available courses here, follow links a number of useful websites and submit your application online,” Mr Stanton said.

Courses start between December 2007 and April 2008 (Intakes 1-3) so apply early to ensure your application is considered before any closing dates. The main application closing dates are:

- Intake 1 – 28 September 2007
- Intake 2 – 31 October 2007
- Intake 3 – 31 October 2007
