FAQs about applying to university through UAC

Do I apply through UAC for all university courses?

You apply through UAC for most undergraduate degree, diploma, advanced diploma and associate diploma courses offered by NSW and ACT universities. The courses you can apply for are listed on UAC's website www.uac.edu.au or in the *UAC 2007 Guide*.

Some distance education courses are available for application through UAC. Check UAC's website or in the *UAC 2007 Guide*. For other distance education courses you will need to apply direct to the university.

You are able to apply for a number of postgraduate coursework programs from eight participating universities through UAC. Check UAC's postgraduate website from early September 2006 for further details. For remaining postgraduate programs you will need to apply directly to the university.

Where can I get a copy of the UAC 2007 Guide?

Year 12 students will have received a copy through their school or college. This edition of the Guide is for Year 12 students only. All other applicants can purchase a copy of the *UAC 2007 Guide* from newsagents, Co-op Bookshops or UAC for \$19.

How many applications do I submit to UAC?

You submit only one application to UAC, but you may include up to nine courses in order of preference on your application.

What do I have to do before I submit my application?

- Make a note of the closing dates for applications and whether any of the courses for which you are applying have early closing dates.
- Choose your course preferences and give careful consideration to the order in which you place them on your application.
- Read the relevant application procedures thoroughly and check for any special requirements such as an interview or an audition or the provision of a supporting statement.
- Find, or send for, the originals of any documents that will be needed to support your application and arrange verified copies.

How do I apply?

Current Year 12 students can choose to apply via Apply-By-Web or via Apply-By-Telephone (International Baccalaureate students can only use Apply-By-Web). Instructions on how to use Apply-By-Web and Apply-By-Telephone are on UAC's website and inside the *UAC 2007 Guide*.

Non-current Year 12 applicants can choose to apply via Apply-By-Web or they can submit an application form (Form B) which is available inside the *UAC 2007 Guide* marked 'Application Form Enclosed'. UAC does not accept faxed, photocopied or emailed forms, or forms from previous years. If received, they will not be processed and will be returned immediately.

Who can I contact with questions about my application?

If you have questions about completing your application, you can telephone UAC on (02) 9752 0200 or visit the office in person at Quad 2, 8 Parkview Drive Homebush Bay (near Olympic Park railway station) in Sydney. You can also contact UAC by email via UAC's website at www.uac.edu.au. If your questions are about course content or admission requirements, we recommend that you contact the relevant university directly.
